# Main features of proposal ....

## Cobbles:


- drop kerb height for easier wheel chair access;
- ☐ tidy up cobbles and where needed re-lay;
- extend cobble area [yellow] to improve wheel chair access to tables.

## Information board:

□ replace rotting wood - with metal frame and mount info plaque on slate. [This will make it more durable to weather]

## **Benches:**

- □ replace with recycled plastic benches that are durable to the weather and will need less maintenance;
- choose "walk through" design to make benches more accessible for those with mobility issues;
- choose design with extended table top to enable those in wheel chairs to use the table.
- ☐ [Existing benches, if sound, to go to Houghton Playing Field]








